What is the purpose of a citation?

- Avoid plagiarism
- Give credibility to your statement

How to create a "Works Cited" page

-Getting Organized!

- 1. Identify the works you are using:
 - Book
 - Article
 - Webpage
- 2. Organize by authors alphabetical order
 - No author? Use the title!

How to create a "Works Cited" page

-Formatting counts!

- 1. Start on a separate page
 - One-inch margins
- 2. Label the page- Works Cited
 - Do not italicize Works Cited
 - Do not put quotation marks:"Works Cited"
- 3. Center the words Works Cited at the top of the page

- 4. Double space all citations, but do not skip spaces between entries.
- 5. If your entry takes up more than one line, indent the second line.
- 6. List page numbers of sources when needed. Ex. If you refer to a journal article that appeared on pages 225 through 250, list the page numbers on your Works Cited page as 225-250



OF MICE AND MEN


A FEW MILES south of Soledad, the Salinas River drops in close to the hillside bank and runs deep and green. 


