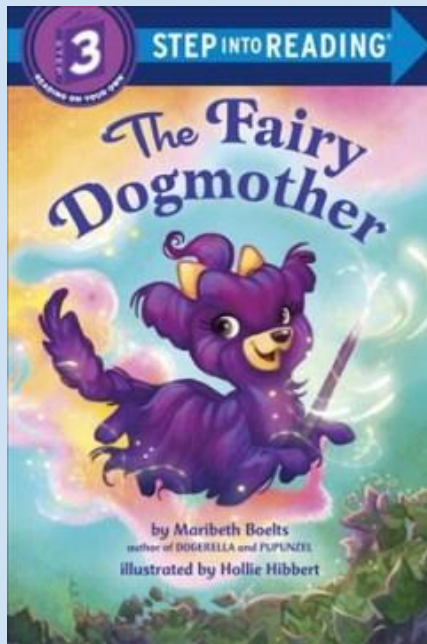

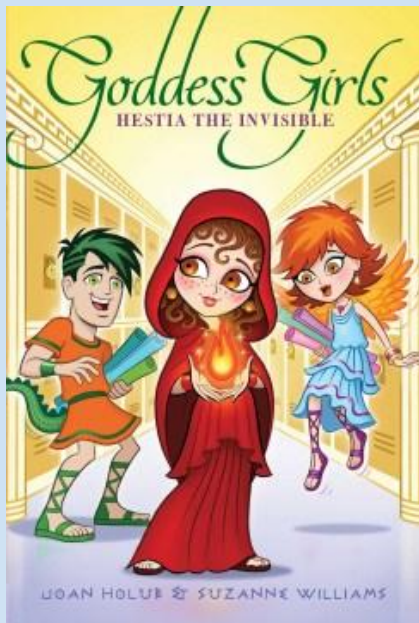

Well-researched and true to the original myths, each volume addresses contemporary issues, like friendships and relationships, from a classically accurate--and entertaining--perspective.

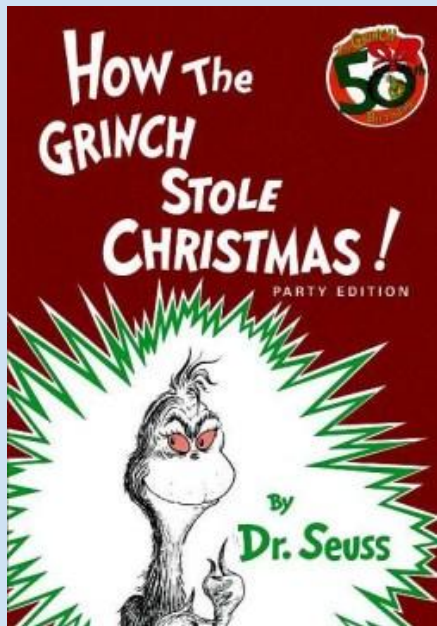

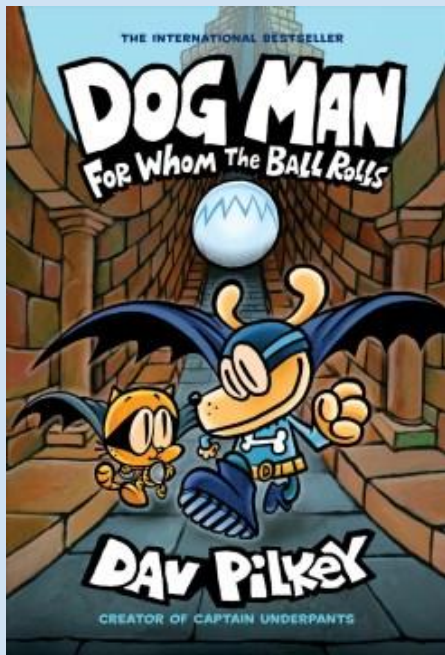

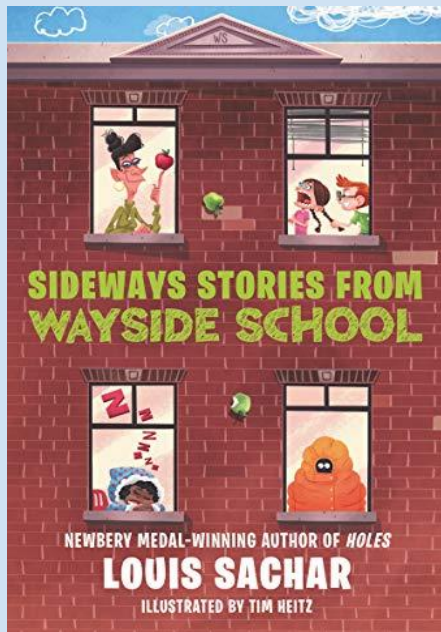
